## Accuracy

- ? Information supported by data

- ? Claims can be cross-verified
- ? No obvious errors or inconsistencies

## **Bias & Objectivity**

- ? Balanced perspective
- ? Acknowledges alternative viewpoints
- ? No excessive emotional or persuasive language

## **Relevance**

- ? Directly relates to research question
- ? Provides useful insight or data
- ? Adds value beyond existing sources
